## **Upper Shores Library to Bring FDR to Life During Two, One-Man Shows**

LAVALLETTE – Actor, director and educator Neill Hartley will portray President Franklin Delano Roosevelt, FDR, during a two-part series to be held at the Upper Shores Branch of the Ocean County Library, 112 Jersey City Ave. Lavallette.

On Wednesday, Sept. 20 at 7 p.m., "FDR: A New Deal for America" shares the culture of the 1930s and the Great Depression.

Part two of the series, "FDR: An Arsenal for Democracy," will be held on Wednesday, Oct. 18 at 7 p.m. focusing on Roosevelt's time as president during World War II.

Both programs are produced by the American Historical Theatre.
