## Lenape Nation's Turbulent NJ History Focus of Ocean County Library Virtual Program



**LACEY TOWNSHIP** – In honor of National Native American and Alaska Native Heritage Month, the Ocean County Library Lacey Branch is pleased to offer a virtual program for teens and adults, "Indigenous New Jersey: The Dispossession of Lenape Land," 3:30 PM Wednesday, November 15. The program will be presented through Zoom.

Jameson R. Sweet, Assistant Professor of American Studies at <u>Rutgers University</u>, will examine the history of interactions between New Jersey settlers and indigenous people, with emphasis on the Lenape Nation and its current-day presence.

Professor Sweet's presentation will focus on tactics employed by Dutch, British, and American settlers that created a broad diaspora of Lenape communities in the United States and Canada. Lenape people continue to maintain their New Jersey communities.
